Anti-Cruelty became a Pets for Life partner in 2022. PFL is a core program of Humane World for Animals that works to increase access to pet resources in underserved communities by providing veterinary care, supplies, and information at no cost to people and pets. Through proactive, door-to-door outreach, PFL builds trust, creates long-term relationships, and offers consistent support.

Our PFL work is grounded in the belief that everyone deserves the opportunity to experience the benefits, joy, and unconditional love that come from having a pet.

In Chicagoland, nearly 1 in 5 residents live below the poverty line, with many more hovering just above and struggling to access pet services.
