Three years ago, Anti-Cruelty became a Humane World for Animals Pets for Life partner in Chicago to increase access to pet services. We are committed to ensuring everyone has the opportunity to experience the benefits, joy, and comfort that come from the human-animal bond.

Our Pets for Life program works to increase access to care for people and pets experiencing poverty or living in underserved areas by providing veterinary care, supplies, transportation, and information at no cost.

Systemic inequities and institutional barriers create immense challenges for millions of people every day, including a lack of access to pet resources. In Chicagoland, nearly 1 in 5 residents live below the poverty line.



Through door-to-door outreach in Greater Roseland, North Lawndale, and East Garfield Park and by facilitating pet support services, Pets for Life builds trust, fosters positive relationships, and develops long-term community partnerships.

- 818 people and 1,725 pets reached
- 11,801 medical services delivered

- 47% of clients utilized our pet transportation services.
